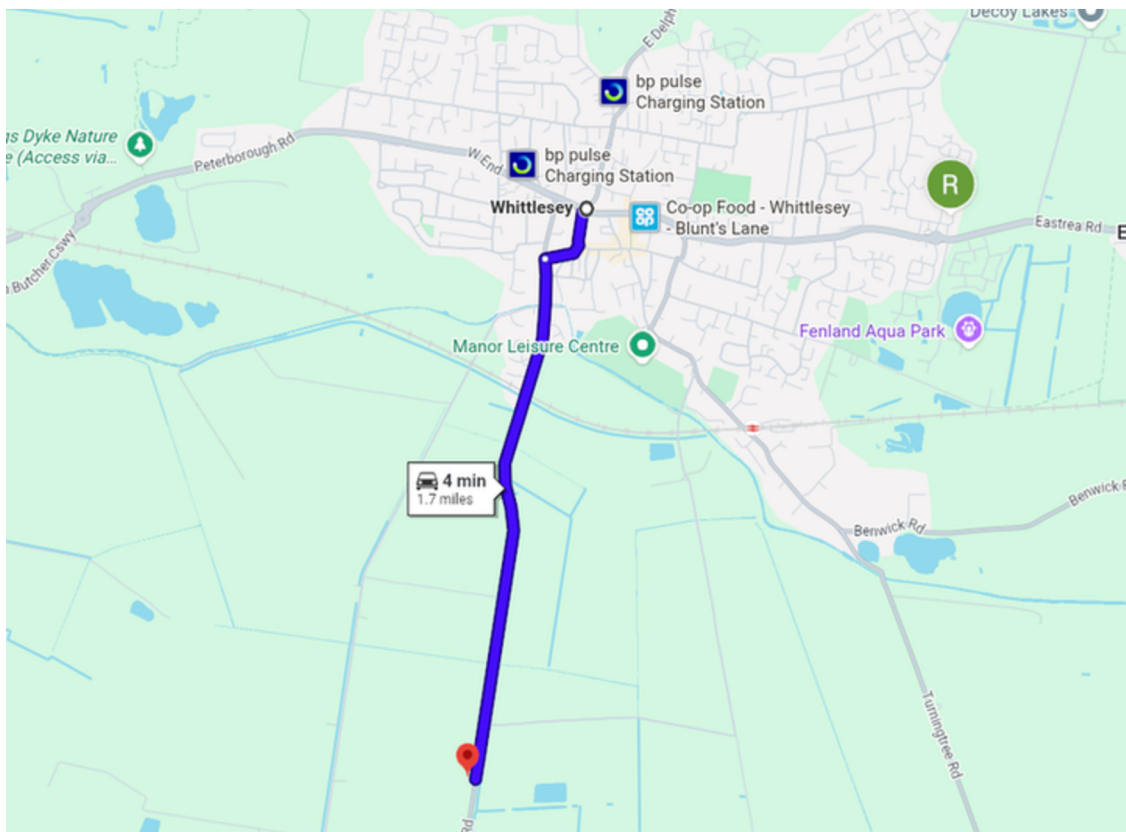
Address: Field behind 108-110 Ramsey Road, Whittlesey, PE7 1DR.

Entrance: Look for the FiveJays sign by the gate on the main road.

Directions From Whittlesey Town Centre (The Market Place/Buttercross Area)

1. From the Market Place, head east toward High Causeway.
2. Turn right onto Ramsey Road (B1040).
3. Follow the B1040 Ramsey Road for approximately 1.5 miles.
4. Pass the residential houses on your right
5. Look out for the FiveJays sign by the the gate on your right.
6. Turn into the gate and drive through the field to the back
7. At the back of the field turn right to where the training area is located.

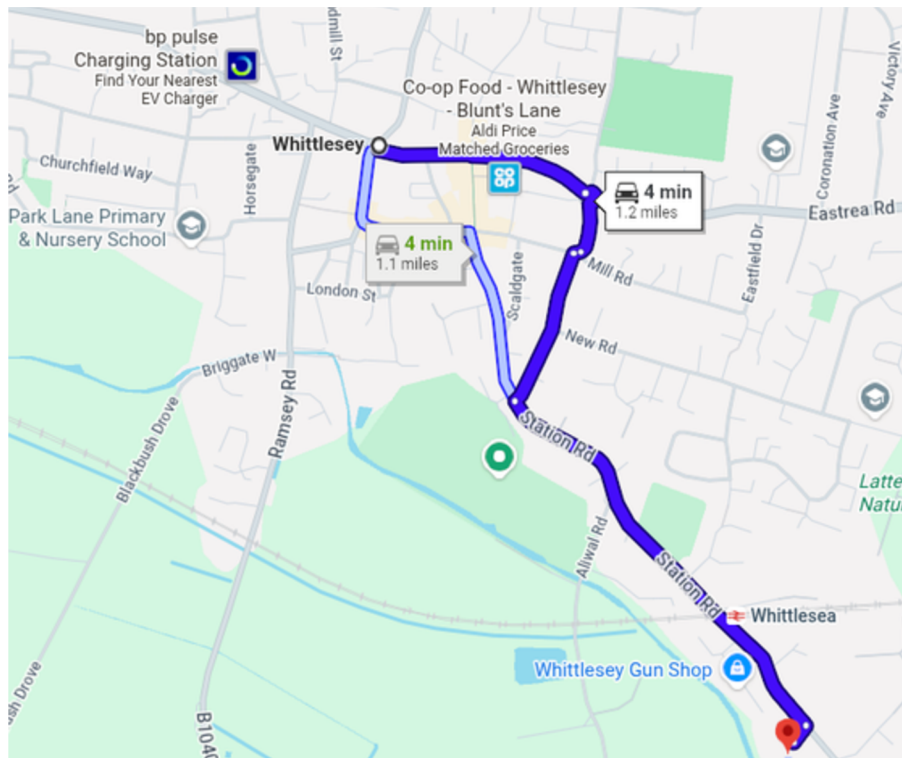

Directions From Whittlesey Town Centre (The Market Place/Buttercross Area)

1. From the Market Place, head south on Market Street toward the church.
2. Turn left onto Station Road (B1093).
3. Follow Station Road south, heading toward the railway station.
4. Continue over the railway level crossing by the train station.
5. Shortly after the crossing, you will see the Whittlesey Indoor Bowls Club on your right.
6. The Indoor Community Sports Complex is situated right next to the Bowls Club.
7. Turn right into the shared entrance for parking.
